

Enabling Team

Responsible to: Enabling Team Leader

Aims:

During the main meetings, Soul Survivor is really keen for any one who wants to, to be involved in praying for other people.

We recognize the significance of young people being equipped and encouraged to pray for each other and are passionate about modeling this in our times of ministry – however, we also understand that these times must be a “safe” place to receive.

In order to do this we have a team of “Enablers” who have experience in prayer ministry and who can move around the main meeting venue, coaching and encouraging prayer and stepping in where necessary.

You may be called upon to pray when a more sensitive situation arises, but the primary function of the Enabling Team during main meetings is NOT to minister, but to teach others to do so. This ensures that the young people can receive from the Lord in a safe way.

Responsibilities:

To attend a pre-festival training event – dates to be confirmed.

To attend a team meeting on the day of arrival and daily team meetings.

To attend the 11am and 7pm Main Meetings.

To be alert and aware of the way the Holy Spirit is moving within the meetings.

To sensitively encourage others to bless what God is doing.

Team members need to be confident at praying for others and feel able to train others to pray.

Operate under the authority of the Enabling Team leader and the Festival director.

To make sure that there is always someone of the same sex praying for someone.

If you have any problems or feel out of your depth while praying for people, refer to the team leaders.

Report all disclosures of present or past abuse of any nature to the team leader. Do not promise confidentiality.



Conditions:

Soul Survivor has outlined certain Values and Principles for ministry, which should be read and understood. While on a team at Soul Survivor you are expected to accept and work out of these values at all times.

You should attend all team meetings during the event.

You must be 16 years or over.

There will be a team meeting on your day of arrival which you MUST attend. Successful applicants will be sent details of where and when this meeting will take place at a later date.

Booking:

Please submit a registration form and include a Team Application form with your registration.

Reference:

The referee you nominate on your application must not be related to you in any way. If the minister of your church is a relation, please use another leader from your church and specify their job role.

Application Procedure:

Once we have received your application we will be contacting your minister or Church leader for a reference. We will also be police-checking all applications. We will notify you as soon as possible to inform you as to whether your application has been successful. Once you have been accepted onto the team we will send you a letter confirming this and detailing other important information.
