Village Hosts

Aims: The village set-up is a crucial part to running a Soul Survivor Festival. The principle behind the Village system is to divide the site into smaller areas so that the delegates can be cared for more easily. Delegates can also be located more easily on site and have the opportunity to form friendships with other youth from nearby youth ministries. Village hosts will work with three group leaders in each village to provide a ratio of approx. 1:10 leaders to delegates.

Responsibilities:

To camp with minors (under 18's) in a designated village. If you are a youth worker accompanying a youth group to the Festival, you will be camped with your group. You are **not** expected to stay with minors (under 18's) at all times, but simply to camp with them.

Ensure that delegates follow the site rules at all times.

Form friendships with delegates, particularly those who are on the fringe of the event.

Answer questions and direct delegates to the appropriate teams for information or support.

Encourage behaviour which will enhance the safety and welfare of delegates at all times e.g. adequate sleep, food and water!

Conditions:

Soul Survivor has outlined certain Values and Principles for ministry, which should be read and understood. While on a team at Soul Survivor you are expected to accept and work out of these values at all times.

You should attend all team meetings during the event.

You must be 18 years or over.

There will be a team meeting on your day of arrival which you **MUST** attend. Successful applicants will be sent details of where and when this meeting will take place at a later date.

We will notify you as soon as possible to inform you as to whether your application has been successful. Once you have been accepted onto the team we will send you a letter confirming this and detailing other important information.
